

**2009 INCENTIVE BONUS SCHEME FOR JAPANESE BRED HORSES**  
**THAT WIN IN MALAYSIA OR SINGAPORE**

1. **Objective**

- a. To promote and publicise Japanese-bred horses and Japanese auction sales in Malaysia and Singapore.
- b. To create awareness among owners and trainers and make Japanese auction sales more attractive.

2. **Proposal**

An incentive bonus will be paid to owners of winning horses according to the following conditions:-

**Conditions For Payment**

- a. The horse must be a Japanese-bred and have a record of being sold at a Japanese auction.
- b. Payment of the bonus will be made on behalf of the JBBA by the Penang Turf Club for horses based in Malaysia (Penang, Perak or Selangor) and by the Singapore Turf Club for horses based in Singapore.
- c. The horse must be based with one of the Penang, Perak, Selangor and Singapore Turf Clubs (hereinafter referred to as “the 4 Turf Clubs”).
- d. The horse must officially be based with a trainer based at one of the 4 Turf Clubs at least one month before its win or since registration.
- e. If the horse is not the subject of any inquiry, payment will be made 21 days after the race meeting.
- f. In the event of a deadheat among two or more horses that qualify for the bonus, the bonus amount will be shared equally among these horses.
- g. A horse that is disqualified from the race will not be eligible for the incentive bonus.
- h. The incentive bonus will **not** be applicable to races confined to home-based horses at the 3 Malaysian Turf Clubs.

- i. The incentive bonus will also be applicable to cross border races when Malaysian horses go over to participate in Singapore or vice versa.
- j. The trainer/owner of the horse must submit his claim to Penang Turf Club for horses based in Malaysia (Penang, Perak or Selangor) and to the Singapore Turf Club for horses based in Singapore, within a month from the date of the race.
- k. A horse will only be eligible to win up to two bonuses during its racing career regardless of change in owner or trainer; any horse that has won the bonus twice or more in 2008 will not be eligible.

3. **Applicable races**

- a. For Malaysia, the bonus will be applicable to races with total prizemoney of less than RM200,000 held during the period of March 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009.
- b. For Singapore, the bonus will be applicable to races with total prizemoney of less than S\$200,000 held during the period of March 1, 2009 to December 31, 2009.

4. **Bonus details**

- a. Fixed bonus of RM20,000 per race for horses that win in Malaysia (Penang, Perak or Selangor).
  - b. Fixed bonus of S\$20,000 per race for horses that win in Singapore.
  - c. Maximum of 15 bonuses for horses based in Malaysia. The first 10 bonuses will be paid by the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association and the subsequent five bonuses by Penang Turf Club.
  - d. Maximum of 10 bonuses for horses based in Singapore.
  - e. Claims shall be paid based on the order of the date and time of race.
5. In the event of any dispute, the decision of the Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association shall be final.
6. Japan Bloodhorse Breeders' Association reserves the right to terminate this scheme at any time without assigning any reason thereto.
